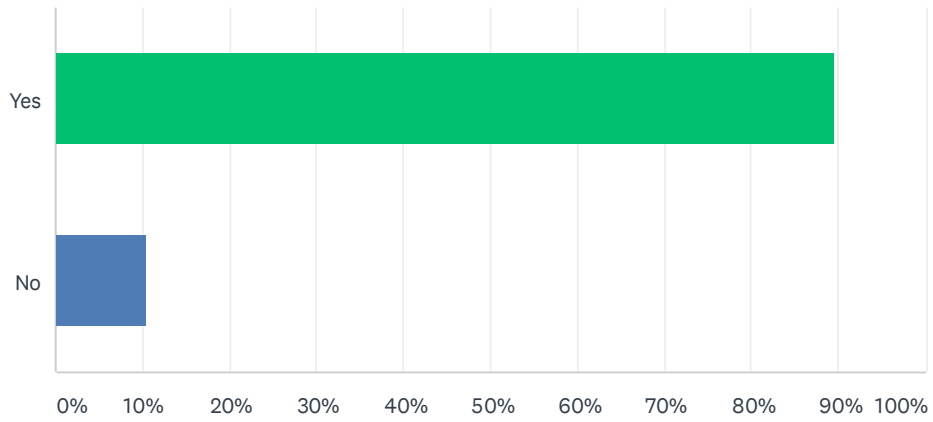


Q1 Is the property you own in Woodbury a second home?

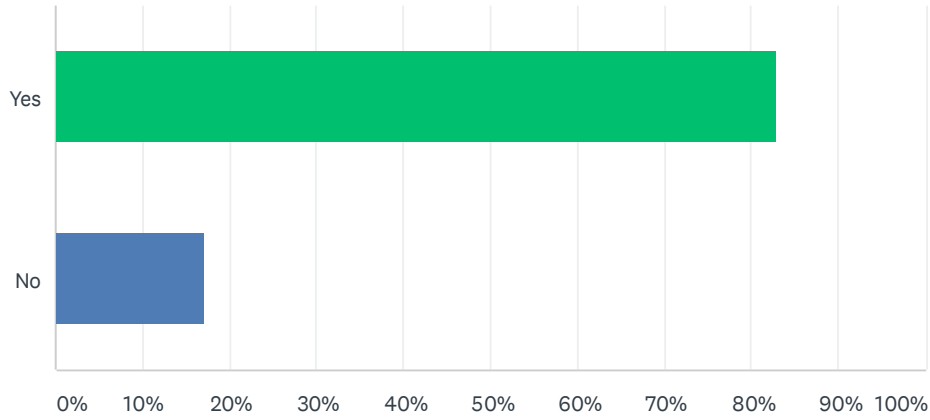

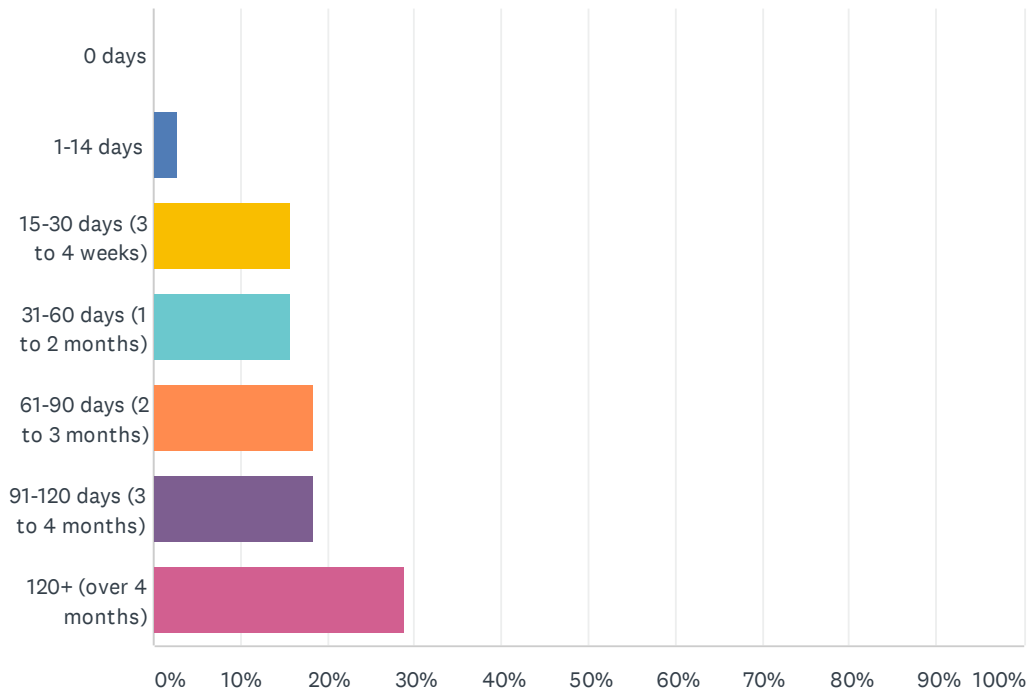

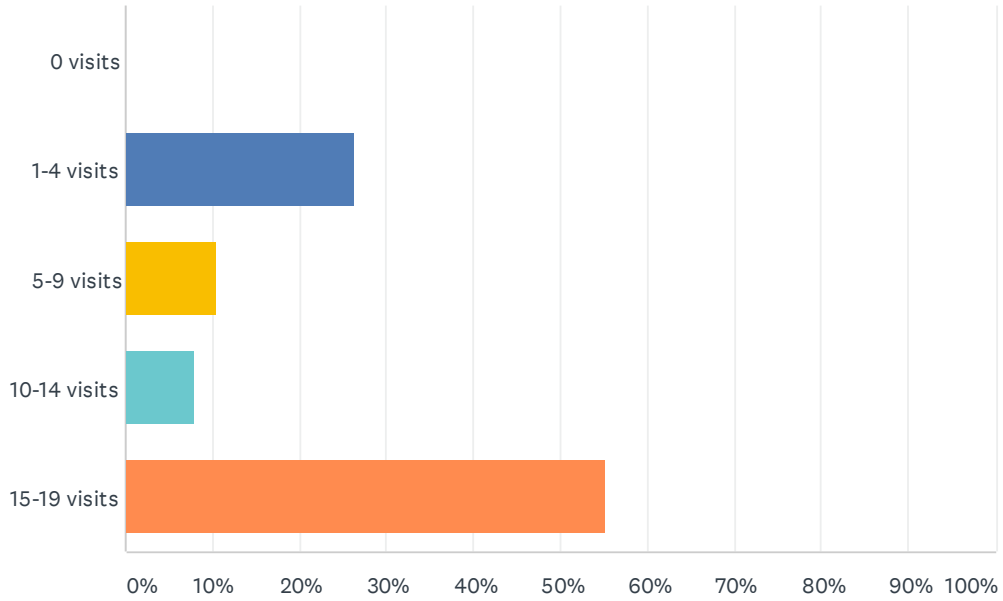

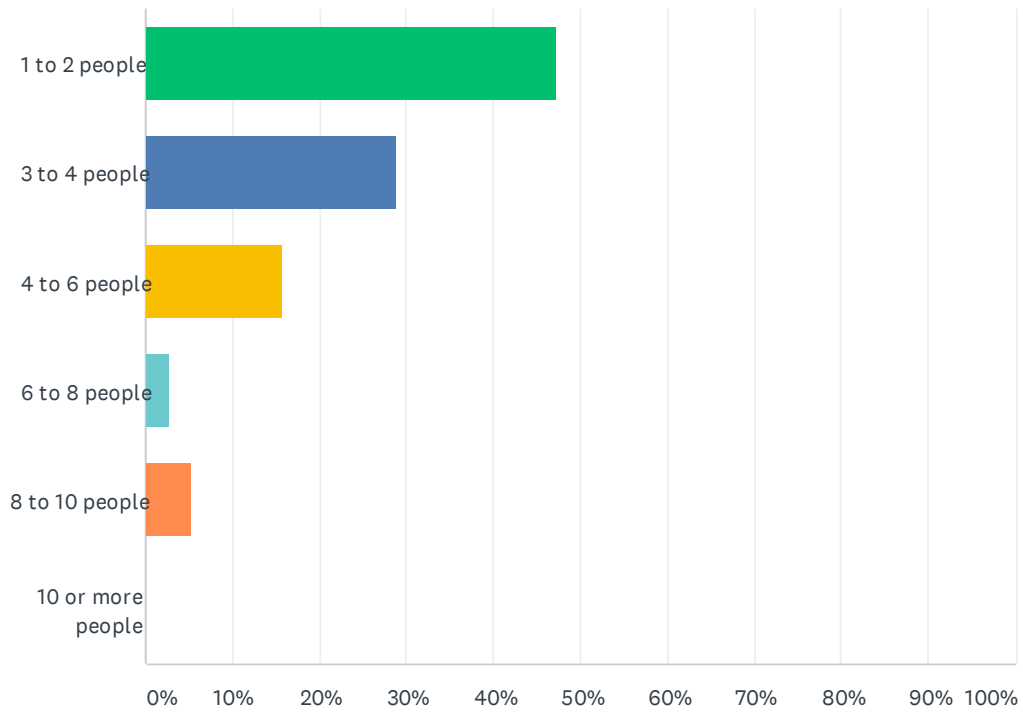

Q7 On average what is your party size when visiting your property in Woodbury?

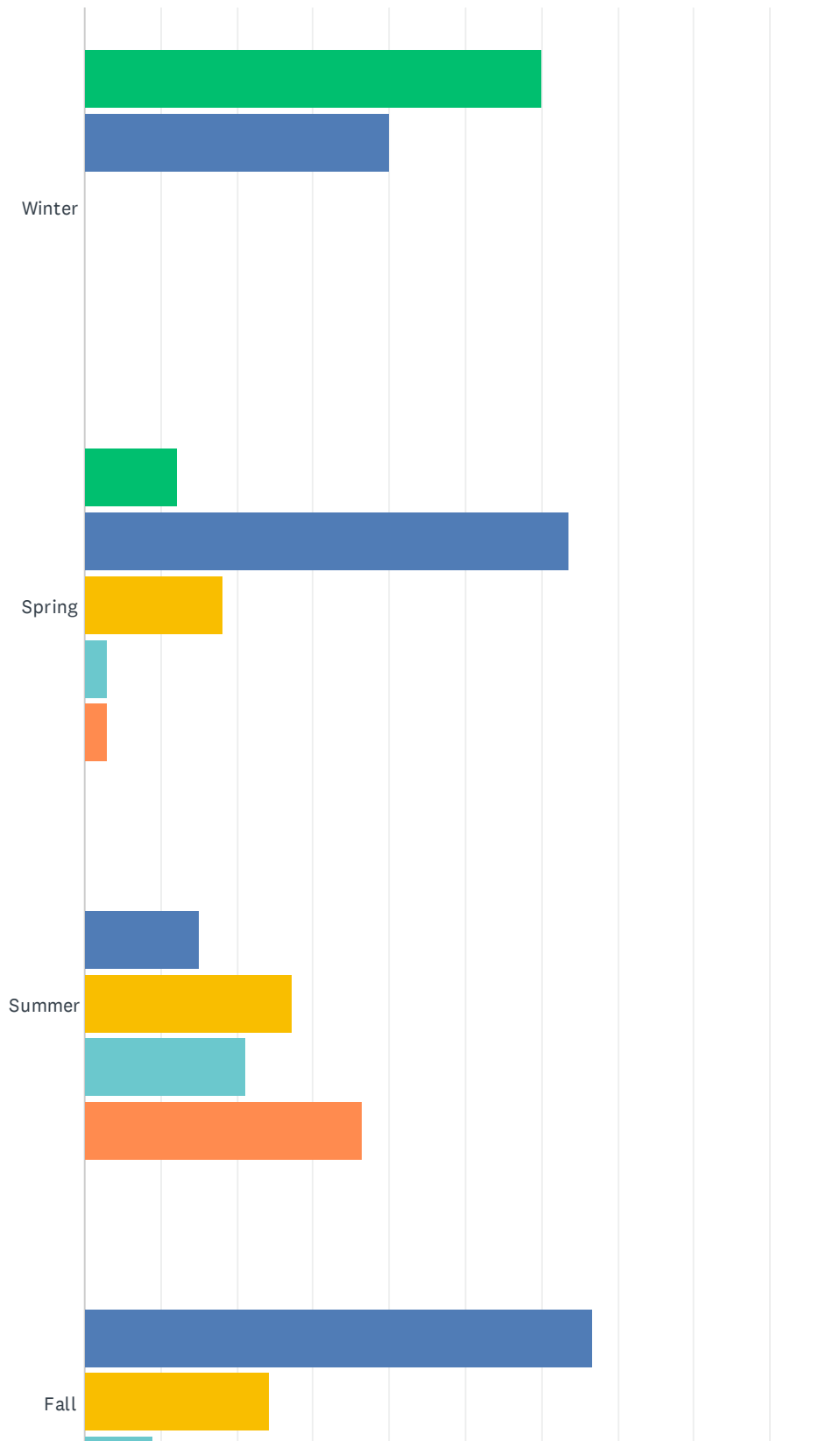

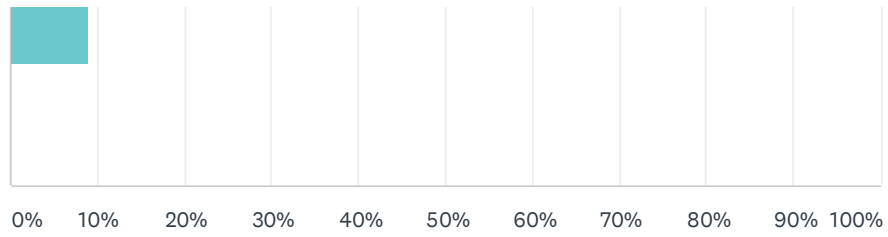

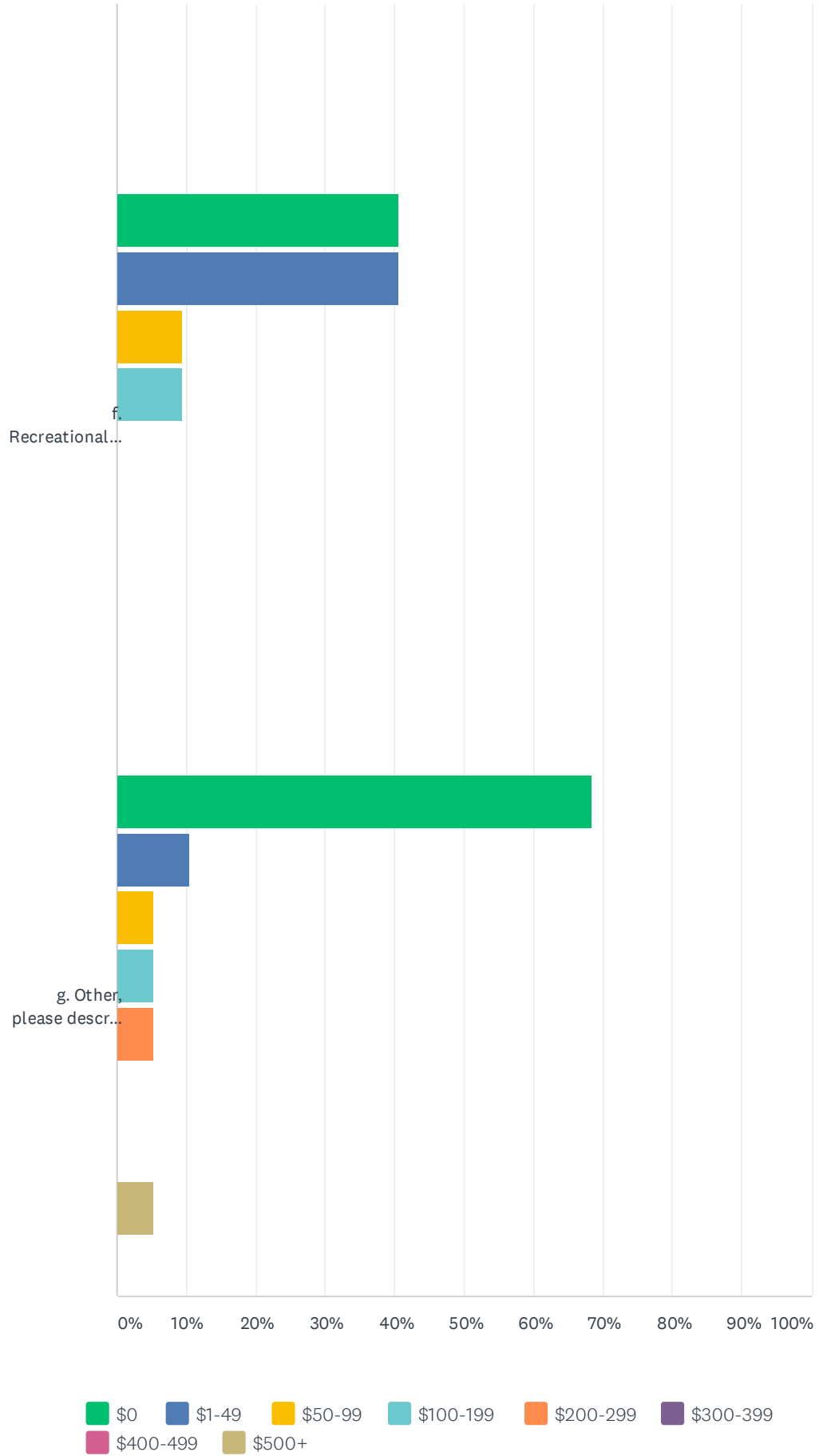

Q12 When visiting your Woodbury property for a week how much does your party spend during the trip in the following categories?

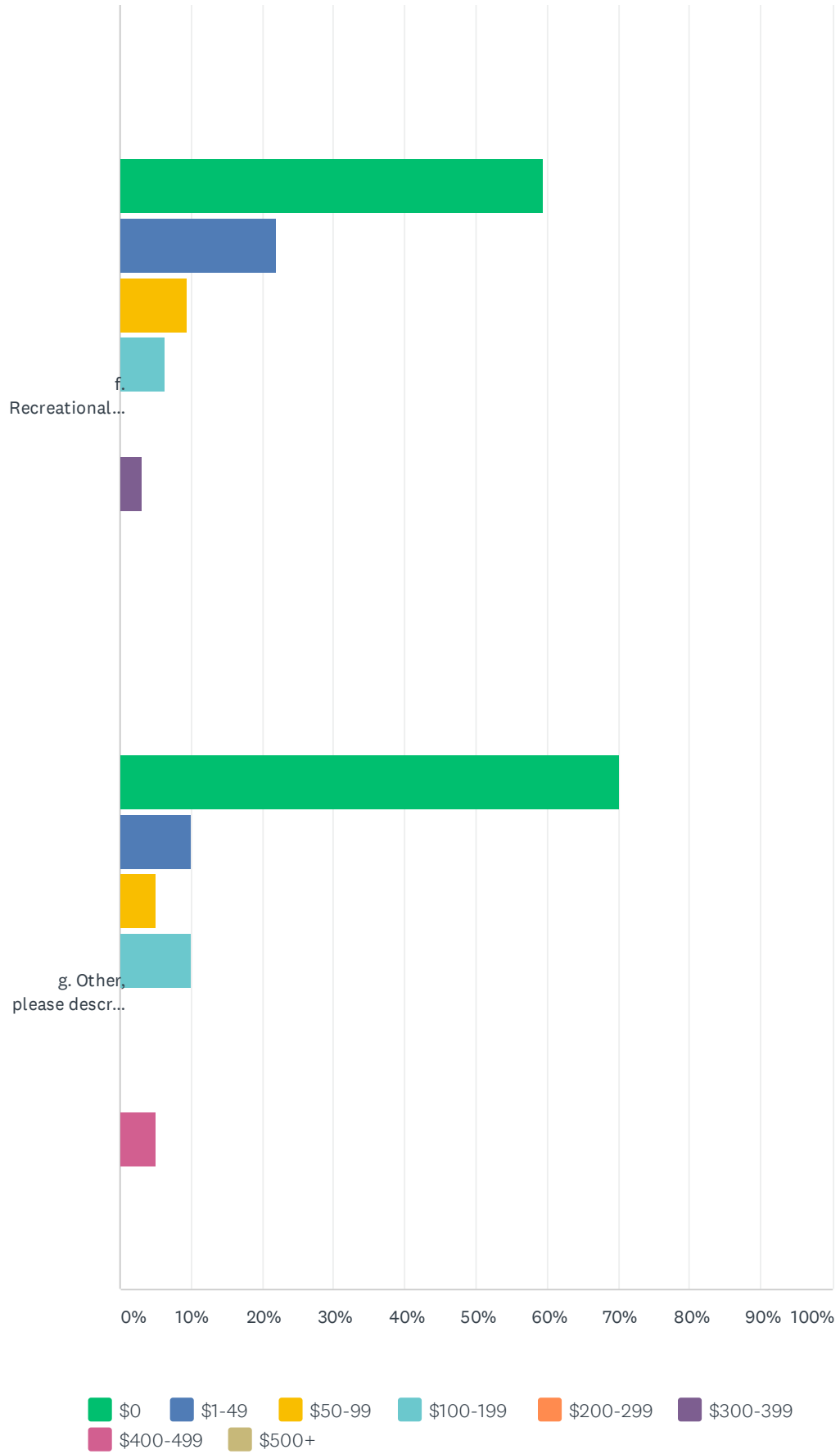

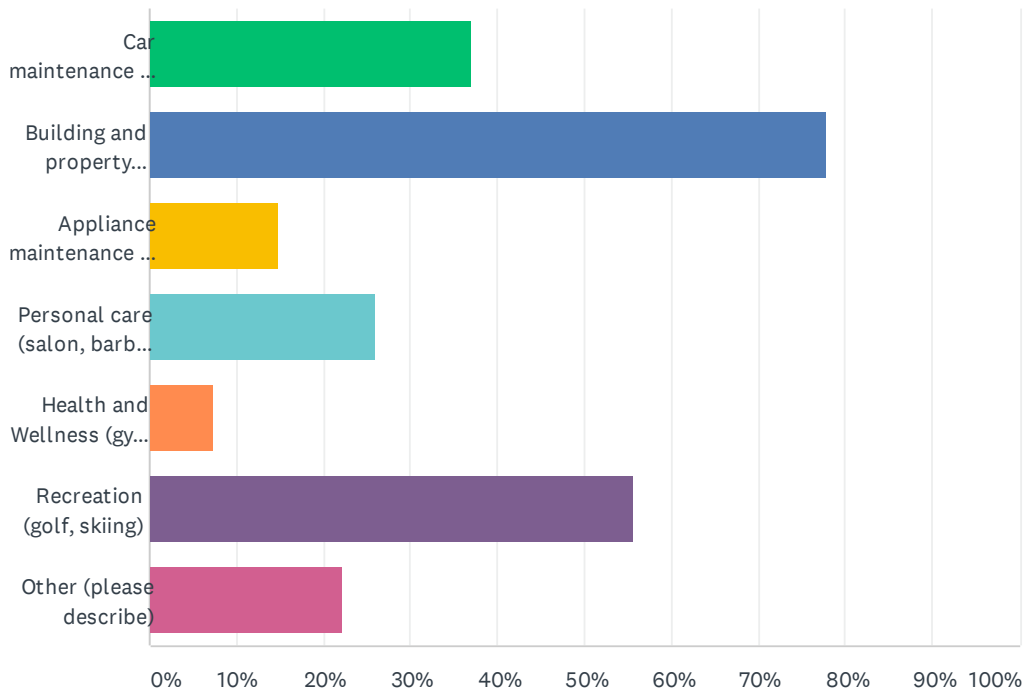

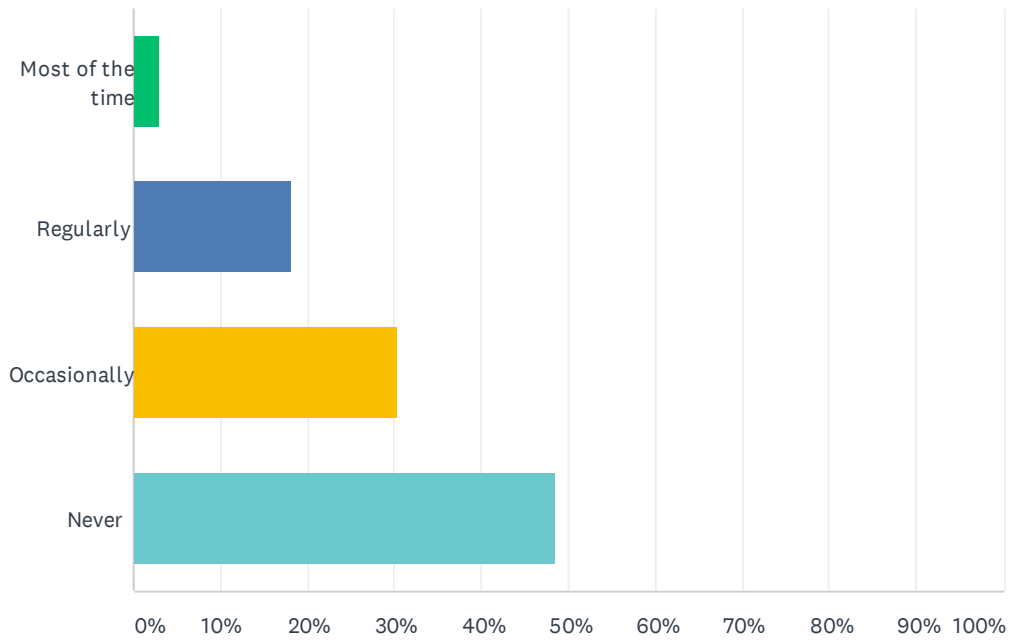

Q14 What percentage of your time at your second home is spent working remotely for professional purposes?

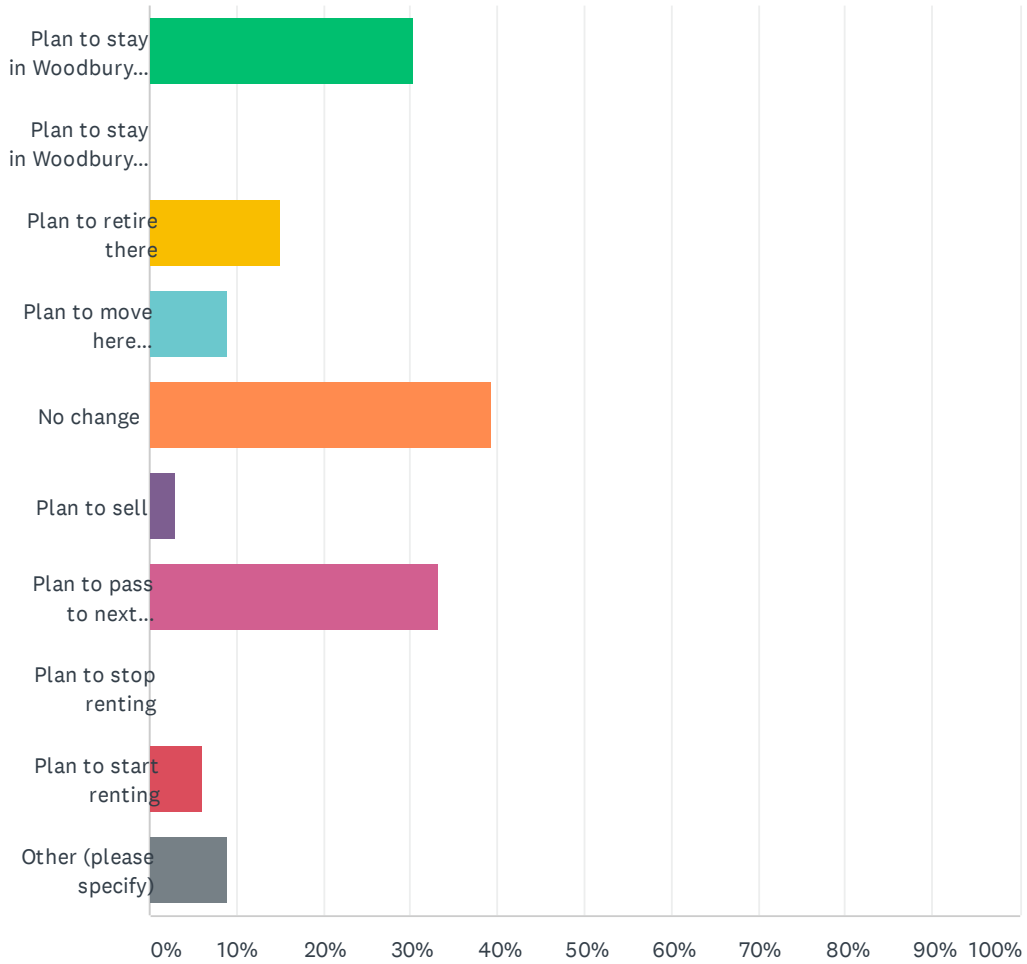

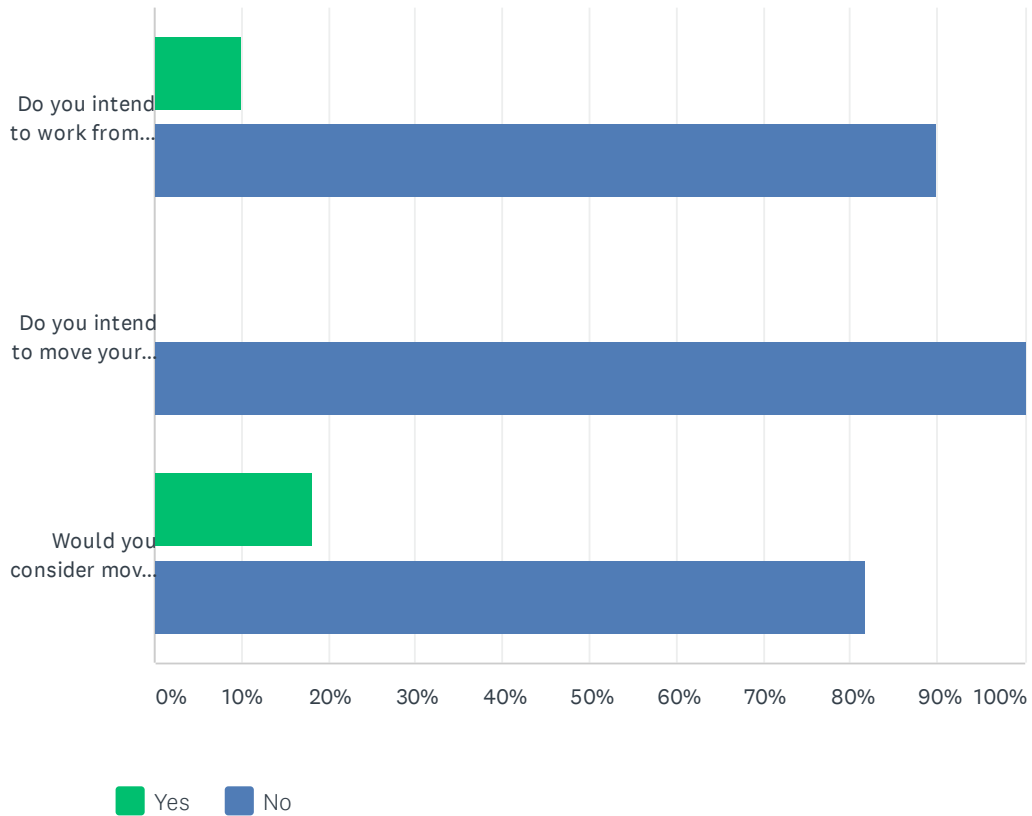

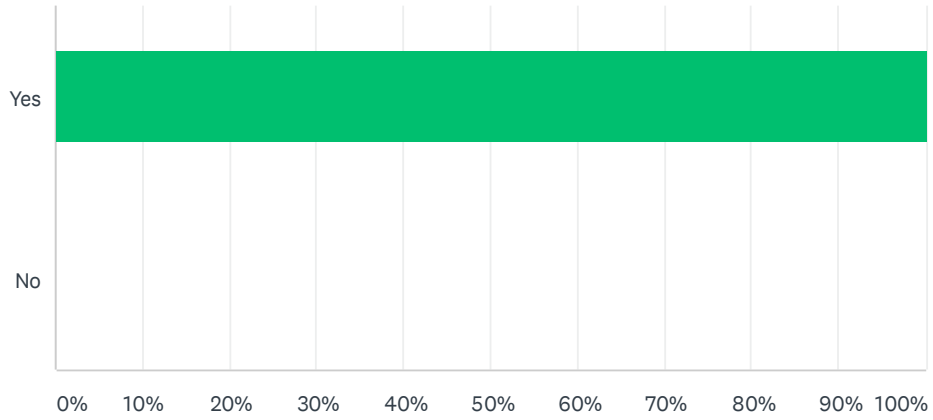

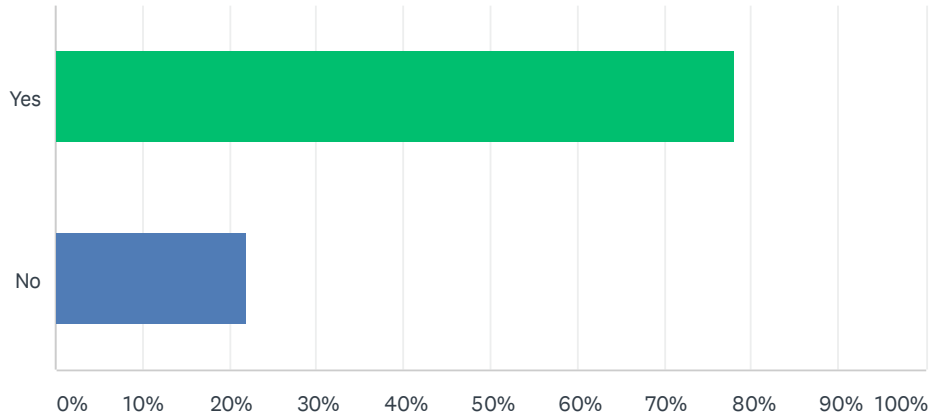

Q18 Do you feel an attachment to second home community?

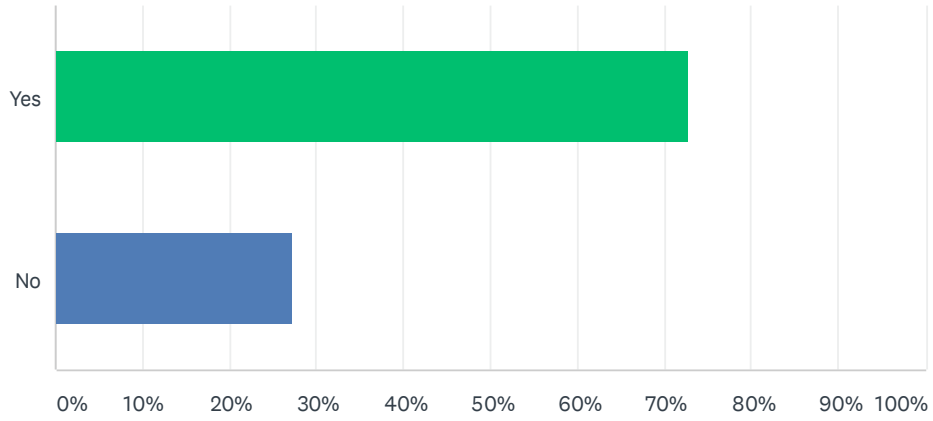

Q19 Do you volunteer or participate in community functions in the community of your primary residence?

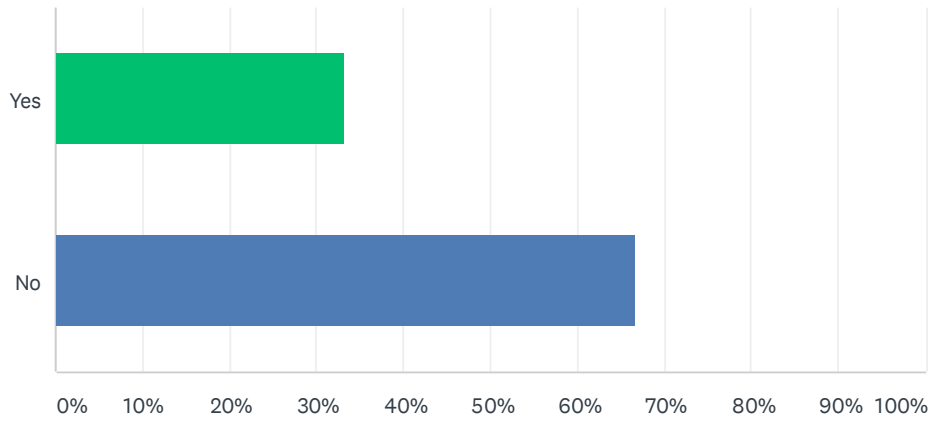

Q20 Do you volunteer or participate in community functions in Woodbury?

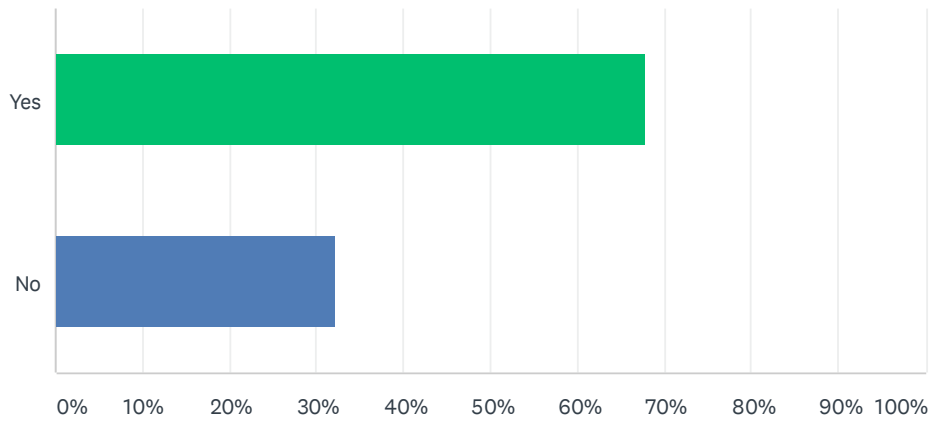

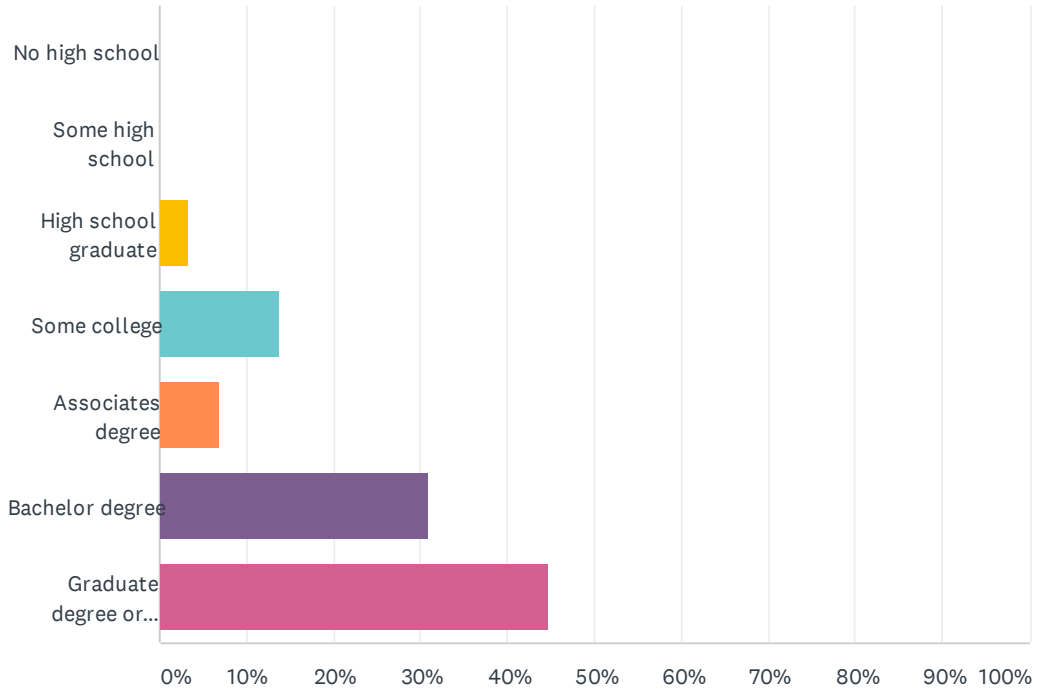

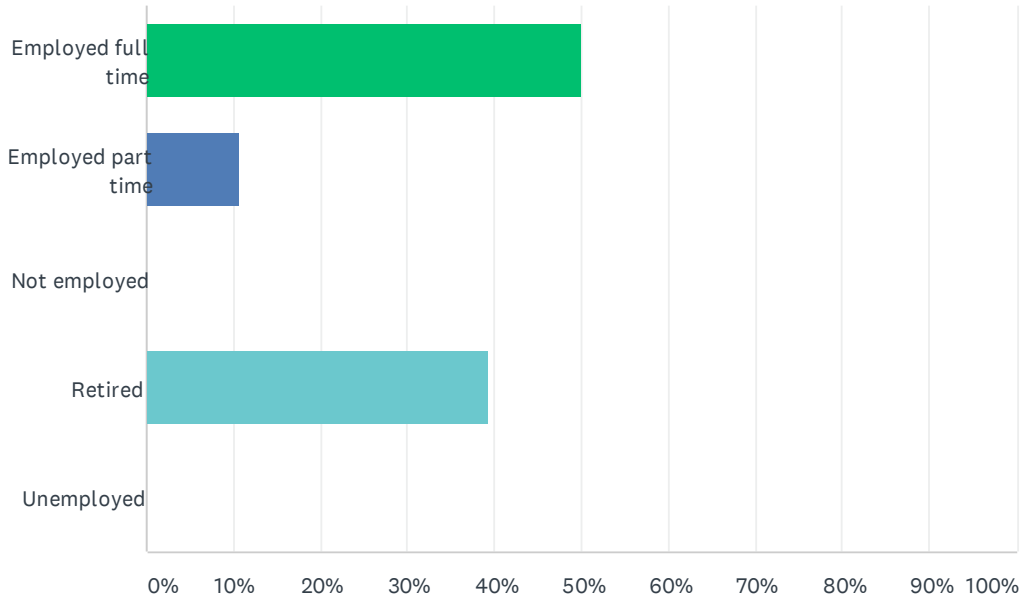
